Prizegiving and gala dinner at Hangar-7 RED BULL


Overnight stay at Hotel Sacher 5*



SALZBURG > MITTERSILL





MITTERSILL > SALZBURG







GALA DINNER AT HANGAR 7 - RED BULL

Hangar-7 is a building owned by RED BULL.
